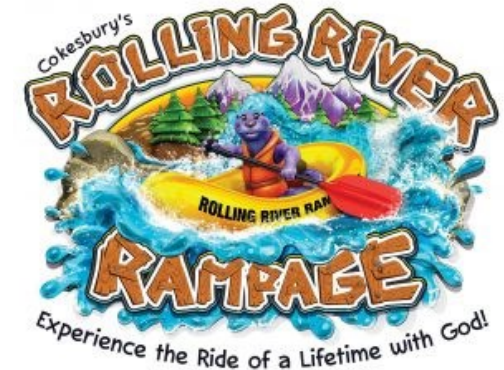

The 2018 Annual Conference session, June 3-6, 2018, falls during the Alabama Primary Elections. Election day is Tuesday, June 5, 2018. This is important for you to know for two reasons.

First, if you are a member of the annual conference, spouse or visitor from the state of Alabama, we strongly encourage you to request an absentee ballot.

Second, Frazer Memorial UMC is a polling location on June 5. The polls are only available for voters registered for that precinct. The three parking lots on the east side of Frazer's campus, surrounding the gyms, will be reserved for voters. Annual conference participants are asked to park in the west parking lots, and additional spaces will be opened on the soccer fields. There will be shuttle services available throughout the day.

Thank you for taking time to plan ahead to fulfill your civic duty and for your cooperation in ensuring voters who are visitors to Frazer Memorial UMC are given ample parking and space.
